Mr. Albinski believes we have a great bunch of kids here; and he has a fine relationship with all of his students, and that he's having too much fun to think about retiring.

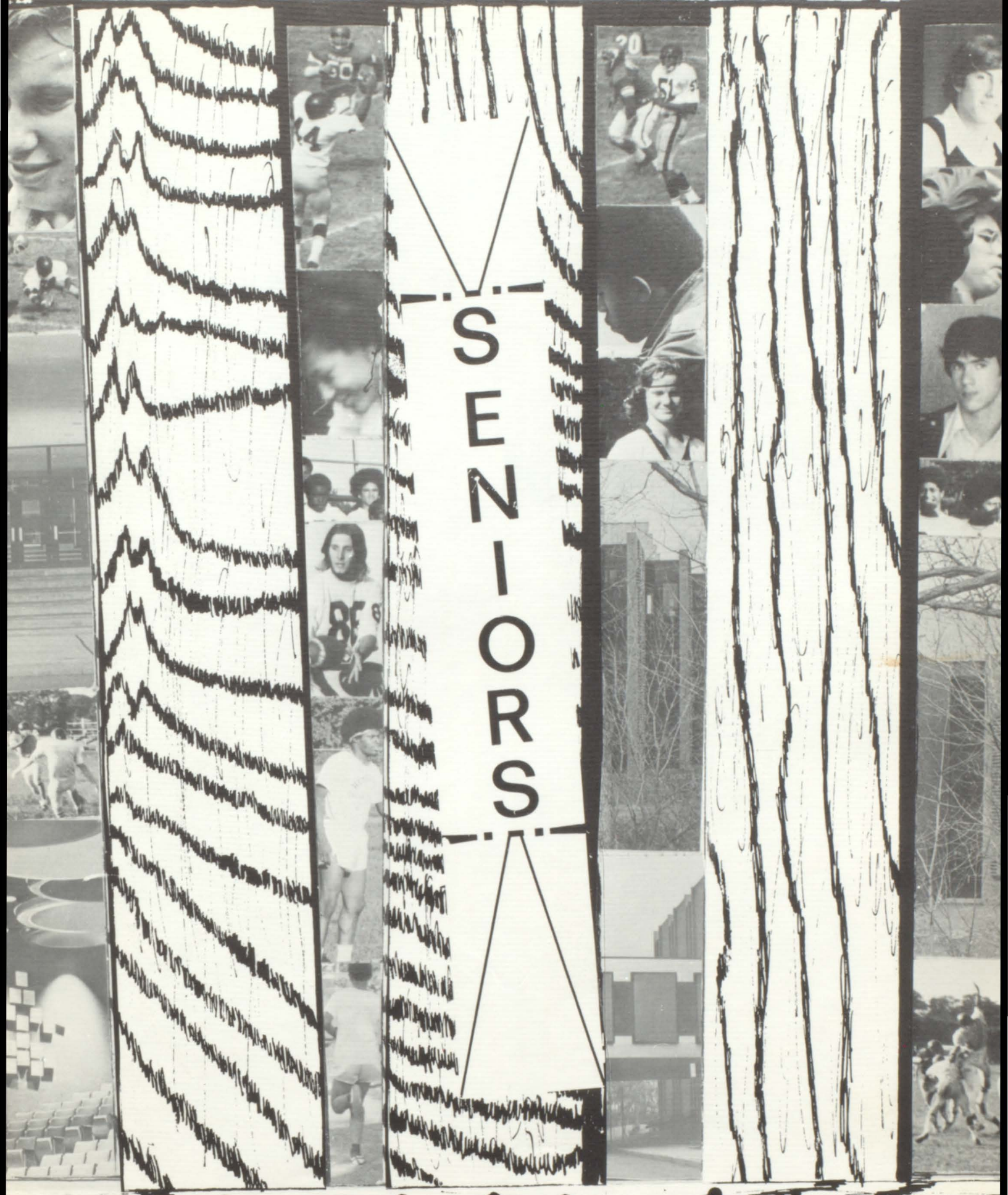






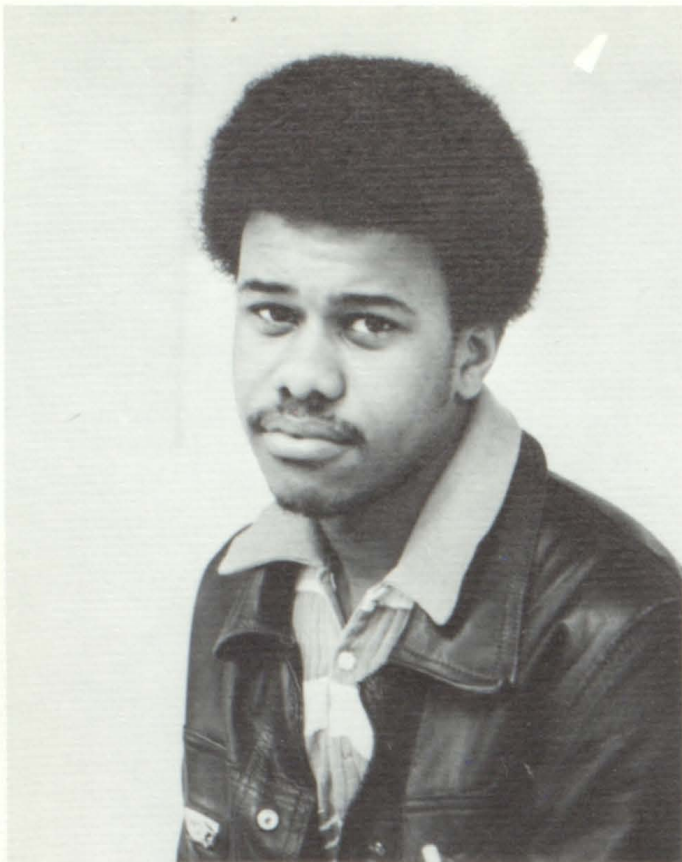
